

# Wine by the Bottle

## *Barbadillo Oloroso Sherry*

10.00

Aged in casks in the traditional Solera system within the ancient cathedral style cellars of Barbadillo, this wine was allowed to oxidize slowly over many years to attain its rich aroma. Oloroso means aromatic. This aging process gives this sherry its dark amber color, rich walnut aroma, and deep, generous flavors. Pure unsweetened Oloroso, it is very dry.

**Spain. White. Very dry. 18%. Best served slightly chilled.**

## *Cascina Bongiovanni Arneis Langhe 2015*

9.00

Davide Mozzone, proprietor and Winemaker, brings us this 100% Arneis varietal from the native white grape by the same name, proudly grown in the heart of Piedmont's Langhe hills. The wine is characterized by an elegant, floral bouquet with intense notes of pears, distinct freshness and fruit on the palate, balanced acidity, great versatility with food.

**Italy. White. Dry. 13.5%. Usually served chilled.**

## *Carlo Rossi Fiesta Sangria*

10.00

Carlo Rossi Fiesta Sangria is a medium-bodied wine distinguished by its bright, fruity taste. Citrusy notes of orange, lemon, and grapefruit are especially refreshing.

**California. Red. Sweet. 10%. Usually served chilled.**

## *Carlo Rossi Sangria*

Carlo Rossi Fiesta Sangria is a medium-bodied grape wine with natural fruit flavors.

**California. Red. Sweet. 10%. Usually served chilled.**

## *Costaripa Valtenesi Rosato Rosamara 2016*

9.00

Boasting a gorgeous, luminous shade of pink, this wine has floral, fruity, ample and intense aromas, recalling May flowers, black cherries and pomegranate. Well balanced and silky on the palate, with a subtle, pleasing almond finish; very persistent, characteristically fresh and appealing.

**Italy. Rosé. 13%.**

## *Eagle Glen Chardonnay*

8.00

This limited production Chardonnay boasts layered aromas of pineapple, honey and jasmine flower in the glass. The mouthfeel is rich and framed by precise acids. The fruit notes continue into the late palate which is subtly creamy with a nutty character that lingers.

**California (Napa Valley). White. 14.2%**

## *Hook and Ladder Zinfandel*

10.00

Super juicy and lush on the palate, with a dark berry compote of blackberry, boysenberry, and raspberry laid overtop cedar wood, black peppercorn, aged cigar box, and subtle hints of dark baking spices.

**California (Russian River Valley, Sonoma County). Red. 14.5%.**

## *Lobster Reef Sauvignon Blanc 2014*

8.00

This refreshing Sauvignon Blanc brims with gorgeous passionfruit and stonefruit flavors, zips along with firm acidity and finishes long, clean, and invigorating.

**New Zealand. White. Dry. 12.5%. Usually served chilled.**

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## *Looking Glass Merlot*

10.00

Looking Glass Merlot exhibits bold flavors of black cherry and mixed berry, complemented by spicy oak notes, with a delicate lingering finish. Enjoy with grilled chicken or pasta.

**California. Red. Dry. 12%.**

## *Oregon Trail Pinot Noir*

10.00

This is a stunning value in an Oregon Pinot Noir. In total, 20% of the fruit was sourced from the Willamette Valley, and all was barrel aged for a year in 15% new French oak. The pleasing toasty scents speak of a far pricier wine, and follow up with graceful, immaculate strawberry fruit. It's balanced out against proportionate acids and tannins and is truly delicious for near term enjoyment.

**Oregon. Red. 14.4%**

## *Seven Terraces Sauvignon Blanc*

9.00

This wine has vibrant fruit aromas of ripe gooseberries, citrus fruits, red capsicums, and passion fruit. The intense flavors of gooseberries and citrus fruits are balanced by the firm finish. Served chilled, this wine is an ideal accompaniment to seafood, poultry and salads.

**New Zealand. White. 12.5%**

## *The Naked Grape Moscato*

16.00

With just a touch of fizz and aromas of peach and orange blossom, the clean finish makes this wine the kind of sweet that's always delightful. Raise a glass to laughing and smiling for no reason!

**California. White. Sweet. 8.5%.**

## *Tisdale Moscato*

12.50

This crisp, refreshing wine is light-bodied and delivers flavors of pear, citrus, and pineapple with a soft, decadent finish. Enjoy with friends and family during any occasion!

**California. White. Sweet. 8%.**

## *Underwood Rosé*

10.00

Underwood has captured the whole "summertime good feelings" vibe with this lean, fruit-driven rosé. On the nose, you'll find notes of cantaloupe, honey and white flowers blooming in the spring. On the palate are juicy red fruit notes of strawberry, raspberry and cranberry. This wine is crisp, with a medium acidity that is just enough to have you begging for another sip - the perfect wine to get you ready for the summer.

**Oregon. Rosé. 12.5%.**

## *Wycliff Brut Rosé Champagne*

12.00

Bright citrus flavors with layers of raspberries, strawberries, and hints of pear in Wycliff Brut Rose. The fresh citrus and berry flavors are balanced with a light body and refreshing mouthfeel.

**California. Rosé. 10.5%.**

## *[yellow tail] Riesling*

16.00

This [yellow tail] Riesling is everything a great wine should be – vibrant, fresh and easy to drink, with flavors of floral citrus and green apple. Enjoy with fish & chips (fries to those of us not from Australia).

**Australia. White. Dry. 11.5%.**
